### **Booking Requirements**

### For existing ARC participants:

Please complete and return the attached booking form with the days you wish to attend. We will then create a Schedule of Support outlining the total support costs. You are required to sign and return this prior to commencement.

### Participants brand new to ARC:

Please complete and return the attached booking form with the days you wish to attend. We will then need to set you up in our system. We will meet with you to complete our Personal Details, Media Consent and Information Release forms. We will also need some additional information - this includes

- NDIS Plan Dates (start and end date)
- NDIS Plan Goals
- How / who manages the NDIS Plan e.g. self-managed, plan managed (with the name of the plan manager)

If you do not have a plan and want to attend as Fee for Service, we don't need Plan information.

We require all forms and information to be completed minimum 1 week prior to commencement of the program.

We will then create a Service Agreement and a Schedule of Support outlining the total support costs that you are required to sign and return prior to commencement.

### Costing

### **Support Costs**

We run our under 18's programs at a group ratio of 1:2 or 1:1 depending on individual support requirements. Support costs can be billed to an individual's NDIS plan using the appropriate line items (this is generally 04\_102\_0136\_6\_1 Group Activities - Standard - Weekday Daytime), or can be billed directly to parents/guardians and paid as an out-of-pocket Fee for Service for those who may not have plans. The Schedule of Supports you receive will outline what the total support costs will be. There are also two other small costs that you will see on the Schedule or Support, Centre capital Costs and a 15min Non-Face to Face component. Centre Capital costs are to cover the costs involved in keeping a site safe, clean and operational. The non-face to face component is to support service delivery, preparation and research.

### Out of Pocket Costs

Entry into venues: some activities we will be running include entry into different community locations e.g. Woree/Tobruk pool, Cinema's, Hartley's, bowling etc. These are identified on the activity breakdown and the booking form. Your participant is required to bring cash or

card on the day to pay the money directly to the venue. Support staff will be available to assist with this and store money safely if required.

Additional money to cover resources: some programs require the purchase of resources which allow the participant to make/create and enjoy/take home. To assist in covering these costs we require a contribution towards these resources. The costs will be outlined on the activity breakdown and the booking sheet. These fees can be paid as cash, Eftpos (only available at our main office: 92 Little St, Manunda) or via direct deposit. If you choose the direct deposit option, please use participant name and program name as the reference and inform us you have made payment.

### **High Risk Activities**

Some activities that we will take part in are considered high risk. These activities have been assessed and strategies put in place, however, there always remains some level of risk.

Please consider carefully your individual's safety and should you choose to attend please provide us with as much information as you can to assist us to provide the best support. The booking form attached will note those activities of risk and ask you to acknowledge that you have considered this before booking in. At any time if the staff feel that safety is compromised or participants are not following instructions to remain safe, they may be asked to cease the activity.

### Cancellation

Programs of Support, as explained in the NDIS Price Guide are a way of purchasing supports that can simplify group-based supports for participants and providers. Our school holiday group programs are offered under a "Program of support". When completing the booking form and signing and returning the Schedule of Support you are essentially agreeing to the Program of Support. Programs of support are not subject to the short notice cancellation rules and providers can claim for non-attendance where they had capacity to deliver the support. This means that once you commit to the days and times you have booked in for you will be billed for these regardless if you attend or not. The exception to this is if you are being supported at a 1:1 ratio. In these cases, the short notice cancellation can apply if ARC is contacted before 3pm the day before the support. ARC's full cancellation policy will be provided to you upon sign up.

### Medication

If any medication is required to be administered while at programs, either regular or PRN an authorisation form must be completed prior to attending and all medications must be given to staff on arrival and locked away for safety. Please ensure you make us aware of these requirements upon intake/booking.

### **Individual Support Needs**

Please ensure if you have any individual plans in place e.g. Manual Handling, Mealtime Management etc. or medical conditions such as asthma, epilepsy, diabetes, allergies etc. that you please inform and provide us with all relevant documentation/plans.
